Sycamore Ranch—"Kulu" in Yuba County--5390 Hwy. 20, Browns Valley, CA

1. Purpose of event: Celebrating Native Indigenous Culture with education, music, art, ritual and friendship.
2. Vendor items must be handcrafted and not imported.
3. VENDOR ADMISSION—SEE ABOVE TIMES FOR SET-UP/TEAR-DOWN Vehicle access allowed only at above times; call Heather, Vendor Coordinators for any questions.
4. After unloading equipment/supplies please leave the immediate parking area free for the public.
5. **Booth fees are:** \$45.00 for 10x10/ \$90.00 for 10 x 20. Non-profits please contact Vendor Coordinators if you have any questions. Make checks payable to Tsi Akim Maidu and mail to %Heather Meharg, 1702 Calle Campana, Roseville, CA 95747, or pay cash on day of set-up.
6. Space assignment will be emailed or mailed to you by September 28th. Event staff has right to designate space and any necessary reassignments. Please work directly with Heather about assigned spaces.
7. All participants are fully responsible for providing, setting up, taking down and cleaning up their own booths in addition to overnight security of your items. You may camp overnight with your items in your space. Vendors are also responsible to provide all of their own needed materials (tents, tables, chairs, etc.) Plan for any kind of weather. *Due to park location the nearest grocery store is 10 miles away and gas station is ½ mile. You may want to bring food/drinks.*
8. ***Please make sure the trash is put in the proper bins—Recycling is available on site.***
9. This is an alcohol and drug-free event. ***Tobacco smoking areas will be designated.***
